Additionally, MPC continues its efforts in promoting drug takeback events. Our next event is scheduled for April 27th from 10-1, located at the Mid-Michigan District Health Department (615 N State St, Stanton, MI 48888). These events play a crucial role in preventing substance misuse and ensuring safe disposal of unused medications. Recycling of sharps within containers and Narcan distribution will also be available. It will be a drive-through event, so participants will not need to exit their vehicles.
