MPC recently hosted pre-prom, a harm reduction initiative for Tri County, Lakeview, and Greenville high schools. Thanks to funding from the Greenville Youth Advisory Council, this event offered students a completely free experience, including prom tickets, chartered bus transportation, dinner, and photos. 140 students were provided this opportunity. We are thankful we could host this harm reduction event on such an important night for our students.

Additionally, MPC continues its efforts in hosting drug takeback events. Our recent event on Saturday, April 27, resulted in 41lbs 14oz of medication and 12lbs 12oz of sharps were collected from our area. Events like this contribute to the health of our community by reducing the risk of drug diversion and misuse while promoting responsible medication management. On Thursday, June 6, we will be hosting two medication drop off events in Greenville from 9:00am - 11:00am at Arms of Love (1220 N. Lafayette) and in Howard City from 12:00 pm - 2:00pm at Grace Community Church (9920 Reed Rd).
